Dear SDC team,

Congratulations! You have been invited to participate in the 17th Annual Undergraduate Seismic Design Competition (SDC) which will be held at the Sheraton San Diego Hotel and Marina in San Diego, California from Monday, March 2nd to Friday, March 6th, 2020. We hope your preparations are going well!

This mailer (Mailer #1) contains necessary travel and registration information for the 2020 SDC including how to register for the competition, how to arrange hotel accommodations, when to book travel, competition location, visa information, and a preliminary draft schedule. **Please read** *everything* carefully!

Another mailer (Mailer #2) will be sent out in early 2020 with exact scheduling details and competition day instructions. Please note: models must be in the display area by Monday, March 2nd at 6:00 pm in their **final state**. Also, the SDC Awards Ceremony will be held on Friday, March 6th, from 12:30 to 2:00pm along with the final session of the EERI 2020 Annual Meeting which will feature presentations from the EERI-FEMA NEHRP Graduate Fellows.

Code of Conduct:

Registration Fees:

The SLC has worked hard to keep the cost for the teams reasonable. Putting on a professional event like this one is very costly. Although registration costs may seem high, all teams have the opportunity to take advantage of a hotel deal to reduce the trip costs. Hotel Deal: Stay 4 or more nights at the Sheraton San Diego Hotel and Marina to receive 1 night credit as part of the registration. This deal is generously provided by EERI to help reduce the travel expenses for the teams. An illustration of how the deal is applied, how to sign up, and redeem the hotel deal is included below. Please note, each team is only eligible for one hotel deal; only one room will be reimbursed for each team.

This year, teams will pay for the hotel up front, and fill out a reimbursement form for the discount (if applicable) after the event. The SLC will distribute this form during the competition. Teams will need to provide proof of purchase, including their receipt from the hotel and a credit card statement or other document showing the charge, so please keep this in mind.

T-Shirts: Each registered team members will receive a 2020 SDC T-shirt showcasing the winning design from the upcoming T-shirt Design Competition. Additional t-shirts will be available for purchase during the competition.

SDC Welcome Event: All registered team members are invited to attend the session where the SLC will introduce themselves and welcome all participating teams to the 2020 SDC!

Refreshments: Snacks and refreshments (including coffee!) will be provided on Tuesday, March 3rd and Wednesday, March 4th for Presentation Day and Shake Day.

SDC Wrap-Up Event: All registered team members are invited to celebrate the end of the

competition with the SLC on Wednesday evening. There will be more details to come about this exciting event, which is generously sponsored by CSi!

Awards Ceremony: All registered team members are invited to attend the SDC Awards Ceremony on Friday, March 6 from 12:30 to 2 pm, held in conjunction with the EERI 2020 Annual Meeting Final Session. A lunch will be included.

Registration Details:

Each team is **required to register for the competition** by filling out the online registration form by January 31st, 2020. Team captains will receive an email with the registration link and instructions.

Each registered team member must be an undergraduate student who is an EERI member. We will check each registrant for this requirement.

Remember, your email address is your user name, and your EERI Member ID number is your default password (unless you changed it). If you can't remember your password, there is a "Forgot your Password?" feature that can be used to reset your password if you've forgotten it.

Before you register, please contact your team members to find out how many will attend the Post Earthquake Reconnaissance Workshop, Walking Tours, Earthquake Engineering Classroom Outreach Workshop, SDC Welcome Event, SDC Auction, SDC Wrap-Up Event, and the Awards Ceremony. Please note, teams/individuals do NOT need to register for EERI 2020 Annual Meeting (this has happened at past competitions).

While you are registering for the competition, we will ask you to also fill out a google survey with some relevant information, to help with our data compilation.

Hotel Accommodations:

The competition will be hosted at the Sheraton San Diego Hotel and Marina, located at:

Hotel rooms can be reserved by following the link on the National Earthquake Conference webpage, earthquakeconference.org, or at: https://book.passkey.com/event/50005129/owner/563/home. The EERI group rate will be applied for reservations made before **February 14th**, **2020**. This date may be subject to change. In this case, each team will be notified by email and in Mailer #2

As mentioned above, EERI has a **special hotel deal** for teams that book 4 or more nights between Sunday, March 1st, and Friday, March 6th, at the Sheraton San Diego Hotel and Marina. If a team books 4 or more nights at the hotel, 1 night of lodging will be covered by participation in the EERI Hotel Deal through a reimbursement request. **Teams are only eligible for one hotel deal.** If teams reserve two rooms, only one of those rooms is eligible for the hotel deal. Teams must pay for their stay at the conference hotel, and one of the nights will be reimbursed by EERI. You are not obligated to stay at the conference hotel, but many teams find this to be a convenient and immersive way to experience the competition. An illustration of how the hotel deal works is included in the table below. The table is only an example and is not a reflection of this year's hotel rates.

^{*} Must stay at the hotel a minimum of 4 nights in order to be compensated for one night. You may stay more than 4 nights. The credit will remain one night and does not increase proportional to the length of stay. Only one deal is available per team. You are responsible for making the hotel reservation directly through the hotel in order to redeem this credit. You must notify EERI SLC with the name on the reservation by **February 14**th, **2020.**

Book early! Teams are responsible for finding hotel accommodations elsewhere if the hotel is fully booked. Please keep in mind that the SDC daily schedule starts early, and the convenience of staying in the conference hotel is often welcome at the time of competition.

Booking Travel and Visa Information:

Teams with members requiring visas should contact us (<u>slc@eeri.org</u>) to obtain information EERI staff needs to provide invitation letters.

Considerations when arriving:

- We recommend teams **arrive by noon on Monday, March 2**nd at the latest. Structures may be unpacked as early as Monday morning (see attached competition schedule). A mandatory team meeting will take place on **Monday, March 2**nd at **5:30 pm**.
- Models may not be altered in any way after being placed in the display area on Monday, March 2nd at 6 pm. Preliminary judging will begin promptly at 6 pm on Monday evening.
- **Teams will not be allowed to compete** if any alterations occur after the end of preliminary judging on Monday, March 2nd.

[‡] Please note that these numbers are for illustrative purposes only. The actual cost of the hotel will vary with taxes and fees.

- Please ensure enough time is available upon arrival to unpack your model and make any necessary alterations before dropping the model off.
- The display room will be available on **Monday, March 2nd from 8 am to 6 pm** for teams to unpack and work on their models in a designated area. These times are subject to change. A SLC member may or may not be present to supervise but will not be in charge of any unattended items, including models. The room will be secured during evenings.

Considerations when leaving:

The SDC Awards Ceremony will be held **Friday, March 6th, from 12:30 to 2 pm**. The awards ceremony will take place during the final session of the EERI 2020 Annual Meeting. A light lunch will be served. and the Awards Ceremony and lunch is included in the cost of each team member's registration.

Post-Earthquake Reconnaissance Workshop (PERW): The Student Leadership Council is jointly organizing a post-earthquake reconnaissance workshop for students on the afternoon of **Thursday, March 5th from 9 am to 12:30 pm**. This workshop will provide an overview of how to conduct post-earthquake reconnaissance as a structural and/or geotechnical engineer and demonstrate EERI field data collection tools. The workshop will include an exercise that will give participants the opportunity to practice making reconnaissance observations using the demonstrated tools. EERI members who complete this training will be well-positioned to contribute effectively to reconnaissance efforts following an earthquake in their area.

Competition Feedback:

The SLC will solicit feedback from teams on how to improve the competition at the end of the competition. Please keep in mind improvements you would like to see at the competition next year and include them in the post-competition survey.

Changes to the 2020 SDC Rules Reminder:

Pay close attention to the changes made to the 2020 rules. Failure to follow the 2020 rules will negatively affect your final ranking. Major rule changes for 2020 include but are not limited to: the footprint of the building, revenue per floor, presentation requirements, architectural rubric, and annual building cost values. If the structural model, damping devices, base plate and roof plate exceeds 5.0 lbs, your team will be disqualified. We *strongly recommend* weighing your structure prior to arriving in San Diego to avoid any complications.
